Conference News

"In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people.(Act:2:17) Then I looked, and there before me was the Lamb, standing on Mount Zion, and with him 144,000 who had his name and his father's name written on their foreheads. (Rev. 14:1)

The conference is over but the battle has just begun for many of the delegates. 159 paid to attend and we had 60 volunteers who attended various sessions when they were not working. It was an awesome time as God's presence was so strong throughout the conference and He individually touched all the delegates so that they will never be the same again.

The first day started with Mark Setch followed by myself. The first opportunity for ministry was given and people came forward and it just went from there. Bondages were broken and people were set free. I spoke on releasing the power of God and the whole conference came forward! Mark and I went around praying and the power of God was coming upon them and many fell down in the Spirit.

The workshops were amazing. Most of the conference chose healing and deliverance as their workshops but we had 20 then 12 for leadership and 10 each day for Banner worship. The banner worship was awesome and just enhanced the worship and life of the conference.

Monday night came and I spoke about getting out of the boat and walking on water. We had three recommitments; some came forward for physical healing and a large group for release from fear and doubts. And then the Lord asked me to pray to release the fire of God and God gave me a prophetic word to speak about His fire coming to Australia.

Tuesday was a special time as Mark taught powerfully on Jesus' leadership style and then asked the Lord to open their spiritual eyes to see Him, open up words of knowledge and visions in their lives. Colin then spoke about deliverance. The Lord then told me to invite people forward to put on the new armour that God has given them for his army. The Lord wanted them to start discerning the demonic over people, churches, communities and nations.

The workshops were again powerful and people were healed and set free from curses and understood more about leadership and banner worship.

Tuesday night, our guest Stuart Robinson spoke about Praying the Price. It was an awesome presentation and challenged us about our poverty of prayer and how that hinders God's release of power. I then was led

to a time of repentance for the poverty of our prayer, our concern for the lost and our deception through church institutional structures.

The Spirit came upon me and I ended groaning as giving birth. The Lord was frustrated because people were not prepared to pay the price (a word given to Mark) and then I was led to call out people who would stand in the gap to intercede as God calls them and 30 came forward to give themselves to the task.

It was very different from the previous night but very powerful just the same.

Wednesday was Stuart's input on Islam. It was very good and challenged us to see how Islam is spreading, what it believes and how we are to respond. His book, Mosques and Miracles is a detailed account of his presentation.

We finished with a communion service where God was putting his army into position for his end time harvest! The delegates were then asked to go through a tunnel of banners, receive communion and then have their hands and feet anointed for ministry into God's army.

The conference was so successful because of three ingredients; the prayers and fasting pre conference and during the conference as teams of two and three prayed from 8.30am – 10pm; the quality of worship during the conference led by a talented team who were stretched themselves in the process; the hard working volunteers under Len and Cheryl (Conference Coordinators), Judy (Registration), Liz(Prayer) Stephanie (Catering), Bill (Worship) who enabled everything to run smoothly and God's provision of Spring St. AOG for the conference venue.

Financially, we covered costs and made a small profit to bless the Lord

Col's Comments

Let Earth Receive Her King

"Joy to the world! The Lord has come. Let earth receive her King." This is a constantly recurring theme at Christmas time. In doing what He did, Jesus showed us that we are loved.

Much of the church's emphasis at Christmas relates to Jesus' coming as a king. It was because He was a king that Herod tried to have him killed. At Christmas we are reminded that Christ's kingdom has been established. It is not just a time of looking back but rather looking forward. Christmas marks the beginning of the reign of Christ. When we listen to the mass media we can be discouraged. Our culture does not indicate that the reign of Christ the king has come, yet it is here that Christ's reign really did begin. The battle may be long against the forces of evil, but the war has not been won.

At Christmas our faith is renewed. Our commitment too may need to be renewed. We are surrounded by apathy concerning the spiritual life, which after death will be our passport to either heaven or hell.

Jesus who came to establish his kingdom is depending on each one of us. You may be a farmer, in a position of a trade, teaching in school, working in any one of a vast array of areas, or you may be a mother in the crucial position of influencing your children. If at Christmas we all remember that we are servants of the great king and dedicate ourselves again to His service, His kingdom must prevail. This is a time to rejoice. To rejoice is to "turn again to the source of your strength." It is then that our joy shall be full. We are to rejoice in the freedom He has brought to us as a gift of His love.

I find it fascinating that Satan has always tried to counterfeit the work of Almighty God. I see it as very interesting that he has sought to transfer the joy of Christmas away from Jesus to santa which reads satan when the letters are rearranged.

When Elizabeth experienced the child she was carrying leap in her womb, she broke out in a song of blessing upon Mary and the child Mary was carrying. Mary was truly blessed to have been chosen by God to bear the one who would save all in the world who would turn to Him and turn from their sin, but that very blessedness meant that one day she would see that son of hers hanging on a cruel cross. To be chosen by God can mean that at the same time we can have a crown of joy and a cross of sorrow. God does not choose a person for ease and comfort. There is no such thing as neutrality towards Jesus. Are you for Him, or against Him. At this time when we celebrate His birth, I urge you to ask yourself the question, am I for Him or against Him? There is no neutral position!
